Take a moment to imagine your life without Police Officers. Imagine you hear someone breaking into your house at night, and you have no one to call for help.

Our Law Enforcement willingly enters these situations we as civilians would not and could not handle alone. And would you believe that despite that sacrifice, they typically are not wearing the best armor available?

Due to department budgets, most officers are not supplied with higher levels of safety vests. They are expected to purchase this on their own, a cost that can be more than \$400, which many cannot afford. After so many frightening experiences with active shooters this year, we, the founders of E614 decided to give every officer the opportunity to receive this equipment, at no cost to them.

Founded in the beginning of August, 2016, we have already had an amazing show of need from officers. Our website and social media is updated regularly with request counts. We need your help with donations and sponsorships to get our operation running faster and reach more officers.

Our process is simple: officers complete a request form on our website, and are verified as active law enforcement. This places their name on a waiting list, where they will wait until we have the donations to purchase their equipment. Donations are applied only to the purchase and shipment of armor. Administrative costs are already donated in full to E614.
